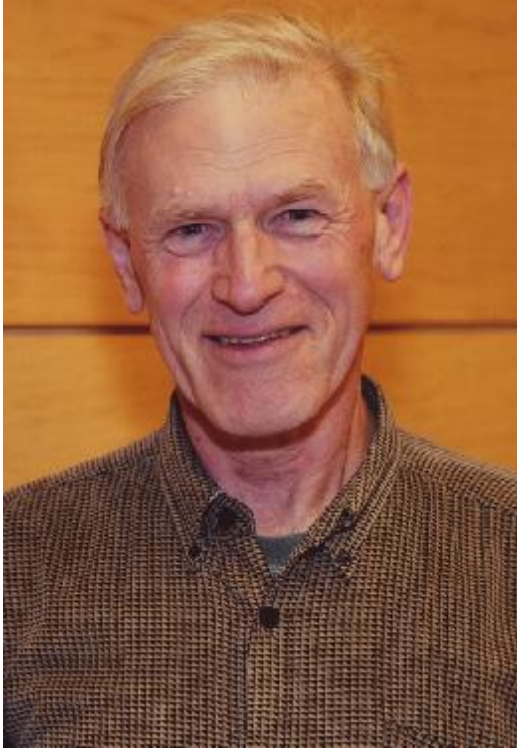


Sid Frere

He has a teaching certificate from the Hamilton Teachers College; a Bachelor of Arts degree from University of Waterloo; a Masters of Education (Administration) from Brock University and several other educational related certificates (i.e.: principals' certification, etc.).

In the 1970s, he was on the committee which was responsible for creating the first environmental studies curriculum for the Province of Ontario. He then assisted in the implementation of the curriculum in Lincoln County.

Chris is his wife, companion, and soul-mate. He has two children. Sid is currently the Chief Executive Officer and one of the founding members of the Niagara West-Glanbrook Electoral District Association, Green Party of Canada. He was asked in September 2007, to run as a candidate for the Green Party of Ontario. During this election the number of Green votes tripled that of the previous election. Sid believes strongly that there are many critical issues which are not being adequately addressed. He is offering his services to the people of Niagara West-Glanbrook and the Green Party in an attempt to correct these deficiencies.
